## About the fair

Founded in 2006 as a joint initiative by galleries from Denmark, Sweden, Norway, and Finland, Market Art Fair has established itself as the leading market and meeting place for contemporary art in the Nordic region. Now open to galleries of all nationalities, the fair has grown from a small-scale initiative into Scandinavia's longest-running premier art fair, without losing its collaborative spirit and familiar character.

The fair's 20th anniversary edition in 2026 marked a new chapter, with a successful move to Magasin 9, strong attendance from both local and international collectors and institutions, and record-breaking visitor numbers. In 2027, Market Art Fair will return to Frihamnen, adjacent to Djurgården National Park and just minutes from central Stockholm, building on the momentum of its landmark anniversary edition.

We now warmly welcome both new and returning galleries to join us in Stockholm, the Nordic capital of culture, from **22–25 April 2027**.

## SEB Discovery Award

The **SEB Discovery Award** is a new initiative for 2027, launched in partnership with Lead Partner SEB. It supports ambitious artistic presentations that reimagine the possibilities of the art fair format and is open to galleries and artists worldwide, regardless of nationality.

The award offers one selected gallery a **fully sponsored booth** for a presentation centred on a single artwork or cohesive artistic project by one artist or artist collective. The selected project will also become part of a dedicated **Discovery Programme**, with introductions to leading Nordic curators, institutions and collectors, alongside public programming and editorial coverage.

### Applications

Applications for the SEB Discovery Award closes on October 21. Galleries of all nationalities are welcome to apply, and there is **no application fee**. More information on the award, what is included and how to apply is available [here](#).



## Venue and fees

Market Art Fair is located at **Magasin 9** in Frihamnen, Stockholm, adjacent to Djurgården National Park and just a short distance from central Stockholm.

### Booths and fees

The fair takes place across two halls: **the Pier** and **the Warehouse**. Both halls host exhibitors and feature a Champagne Deutz bar. The Pier additionally offers a café overlooking the water, and the public program.

Booths range from **18 to 40+ sqm**, with fees starting at **SEK 2,500 (approx. €230) in the Pier** and **SEK 3,950 (approx. €360) in the Warehouse**. Booth fees include high-quality temporary walls, standard lighting, one electrical outlet, internet access, and daily cleaning.

Gallery participation also includes access to an exclusive programme of collector dinners, a professionals' lunch with institutional representatives, VIP receptions, and other networking events.



## Galleries and presentations

Market Art Fair is open to all galleries and artists regardless of nationality.

Market Art Fair prioritizes solo presentations as well as curated duo- and group shows. The fair mainly focuses on living contemporary artists but also accepts estate presentations when relevant. We welcome applications across all artistic media, with selection based on the quality of the presentation.

Eligible galleries are those whose primary business is organizing exhibitions in close collaboration with living artists, and demonstrate long-term artist relationships. Galleries primarily financed by public funding or mainly artist-run are not eligible. Galleries must operate an exhibition space open to the public with a regular program.

## Collectors and institutions

Market Art Fair places strong emphasis on community and aims to engage our guests to Stockholm art scene. We have a comprehensive network of Nordic art collectors and HNWI, and the fair collaborates with leading institutions and arranges several programs for curators and collectors from all over the world.

Galleries are invited to collector dinners, a professionals' lunch with institutional representatives, VIP receptions, and other networking events. For many participating galleries, the fair's social and professional programme is considered one of the most valuable aspects of taking part.

Galleries report strong sales to prominent private collections and public institutions. All galleries stated they made important new connections and **47% placed works with institutions in 2026.**

## Selection Committee

Market Art Fair's Selection Committee consists of current and former museum directors, ensuring independent selection and high curatorial standards. The guiding principles for selection – quality of art, presentation, and relevance – ensure that exhibitors, whether established or emerging, prioritise bold artistic visions, making each edition of the fair feel forward-looking and vital.

## Partnerships

For almost 20 years, Market Art Fair has collaborated with leading global brands such as BMW, Cartier, SEB and The Macallan, among others, creating year-round opportunities for galleries and artists.

Each year Market Art Fair hosts the **BMW Art Car Commission** coinciding with the fair. In 2026, artistic duo Inka Lindergård and Niclas Lindergård were the winners, and their design was showcased on a fleet of six vehicles, including the X5, i7 and iX3, circulating throughout the city and transporting the fair's VIP guests. The competition will return in 2027, with the possibility for all participating galleries to submit proposals.

# Stockholm: The Understated Art Capital of the North

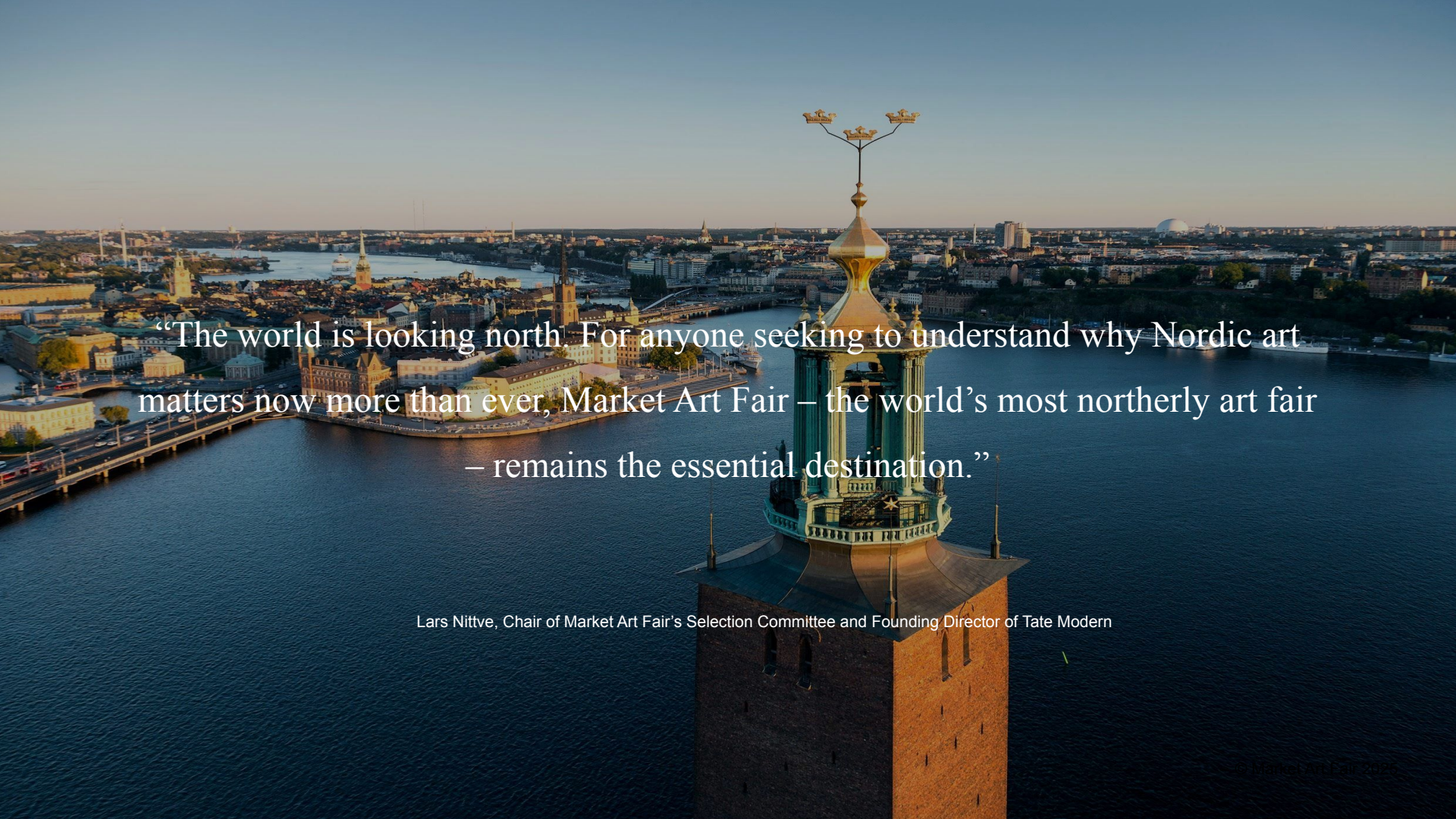
Beyond the fair, Market Art Fair invites visitors to explore a city that has emerged as a bona fide destination for art lovers and professionals alike.
