For the first time since its establishment in 2006, the Stockholm-based Market Art Fair welcomes galleries to apply with international presentations!

Since 2006, Market Art Fair has presented a curated selection of solo, duo, and curated group presentations with the most exciting Nordic art and artists, represented by leading galleries from the Nordic countries as well as recognized international galleries representing Nordic artists. The fair has also presented galleries with more emerging programs, a vast live program of talks, site-specific sculpture exhibitions, and an attractive VIP programme showcasing collections of artists' studios and institutions. During almost two decades, Market has developed into the leading contemporary art fair in the Nordic region and has become a trusted meeting and marketplace in the heart of the Nordic art industry.

For the 2025 edition, Market Art Fair is moving from only accepting applications from galleries that represent and thus can show Nordic artists at the fair to opening for applications with international artists and presentations. This will open the world to curious visitors who appreciate the chance to explore a curated selection of some of the most interesting Nordic and international art locally. Although Market is still deeply rooted in the Nordic art scene, this global outlook and invitation is part of an ongoing expansion, with 2025 marking the start of initiatives that will take the fair into its next chapter.

Market Art Fair takes place in Liljevalchs konsthall on the beautiful island of Djurgården, a short walk from the city center. Liljevalchs has welcomed an initiated art public as well as curious art lovers to experience carefully curated exhibitions for over a hundred years; the inaugural exhibition took place in 1916, featuring some of Sweden's most well-respected artists, including Anders Zorn, Carl Larsson, and Bruno Liljefors. Today, Liljevalchs is an exhibition venue for contemporary art and the site of one of Sweden's most popular annual art exhibitions, The Spring Salon.

Thanks to Liljevalchs historic design and soulful yet airy halls, Market Art Fair differs from the typical international large exhibition hall fairs. Instead, Market offers a boutique fair that provides opportunities to build intimate and personal relationships with collectors and visitors.

Stockholm has and will continue to see a strong buying interest among both established and aspiring art consumers. With Liljevalch's premises and buyers' willingness to discover new art and explore galleries operating in a larger arena, Market Art Fair offers the perfect place to make new, powerful, and lasting contacts, paving the way for future collaborations.

Applications are open from 12 September and close on 1 November 2024.
